Who It's For	All languages	Arabic, ASL (if RID certified), Cantonese, Korean, Mandarin, Russian, Spanish, Vietnamese, Oregon/Federal Court Certified Interpreters
Main Requirements	<ul> <li>✓ Complete 60 hour OHA Health Care Interpreter Training</li> <li>✓ Work/volunteer at least 15 hours as an interpreter</li> <li>✓ Prove your oral language proficiency for English and target language</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>✓ Complete 60 hour OHA Health Care Interpreter Training</li> <li>✓ Work/volunteer at least 30 hours as an interpreter</li> <li>✓ Take a national written and oral exam through CCHI or NBCMI, or have RID certification (ASL), or be an Oregon or Federal Certified Court Interpreter</li> </ul>
